INAUGURAL ROOFING CONFERENCE PROVES SUCCESSFUL

The EPDM Roofing Association's (ERA) inaugural Roofing Technology Conference was held on November 17 at the J.W. Marriot Hotel Pennsylvania Avenue in Washington, DC. Approximately 15 roofing professionals attended the day-long event, which provided information necessary for the selection and design of commercial roof systems.

Attendees who completed post-event questionnaires gave the event high overall marks. Nearly all agreed that the conference significantly increased their knowledge of roofing system performance and design options. The session was AIA accredited with six Learning Units available to qualified professionals.

According to ERA Board Chairman, Nick Shears, "The response to this event has prompted ERA to look at offering our Roofing Technology Conference at additional areas in the Northeast as well as in the Midwest and Pacific Northwest. We will announce a schedule as soon as the details have been worked out.

Topics for the conference were determined by marketplace demand and were customized to the specific needs of the Washington/Baltimore audience. Shears explained that the program will be further modified based on the suggestions offered by the Washington attendees, and that future sessions are expected to include more information on Green Roofs, existing roof repair options and vapor barrier technology.
