## **ERA To Present at Inaugural Energy Efficiency Global Forum**

**BETHESDA, MD. November 12, 2007** – The EPDM Roofing Association (ERA) announced that the immediate past chairman of its board of directors, Dr. Jim Hoff, will be delivering a presentation at the inaugural Energy Efficiency Global Forum, the Alliance to Save Energy's first international energy forum and exposition.

The moderator of the session at the Forum is Hans Nilsson, Principal Administrator, EE and Policy Analysis Division, International Energy Agency. Other speakers include Mark MacCracken, President, CALMAC Manufacturing Corporation; and David Rodgers, Deputy Assistant Secretary for Energy Efficiency, U.S. Department of Energy.

The Energy Efficiency Global Forum is the first-of-its-kind, comprehensive international energy-efficiency forum that will attract industry professionals, policymakers, and academics to forge partnerships and develop "best practices," policies and strategies to respond to the climate, national security, and economic implications of the increasing global demand for energy.
