ERA JOINS HIGH-PERFORMANCE BUILDING CONGRESSIONAL CAUCUS COALITION

Organization Brings Together Associations and Businesses to Inform Policymakers on Importance and Value of High-Performance Buildings

BETHESDA, MD, October 12, 2010 – The EPDM Roofing Association (ERA) has become a member of the High-Performance Building Congressional Caucus Coalition (HPBCCC; <http://www.hpbcc.org/>), a private-sector coalition providing guidance and support to the High-Performance Building Caucus of the U.S. Congress.

ERA joins nearly 100 associations and corporations in the Coalition, which works with the Congressional Caucus to promote and showcase best practices in building design and focus on issues reflecting all aspects of high-performance buildings including: accessibility, aesthetics, cost-effectiveness, functionality, historic preservation, productivity, safety and security, and sustainability.

The High-Performance Buildings Caucus of the U.S. Congress was formed to heighten awareness and inform policymakers about the major impact buildings have on our health, safety and welfare and the opportunities to design, construct and operate high-performance buildings that reflect our concern for these impacts. Fundamental to these concerns are protecting life and property, developing novel building technologies, facilitating and enhancing U.S. economic competitiveness, increasing energy efficiency in the built-environment, assuring buildings have minimal climate change impacts and are able to respond to changes in the environment, and supporting the development of private sector standards, codes and guidelines that address these concerns.

The lead organization in the coalition is The American Society of Heating, Refrigerating and Air-Conditioning Engineers (ASHRAE). The co-chairs of the High-Performance Buildings Caucus are Rep. Russ Carnahan (D-MO), and Rep. Judy Bigger (R-IL).
